

CANCELLATION NOTICE March 16, 2020

On March 12, 2020, the City of St. Louis banned gatherings of more than 1000 people in order to restrict the spread of the coronavirus. In response to that direction, *our leadership team has decided to cancel The Prayer Breakfast for Greater St. Louis scheduled for April 8, 2020.*

The safety and well-being of our guests is our primary concern. To proceed with this large event would mean the possibility of placing attendees at risk.
